DUTIES OF TEACHERS

Each teacher on beginning a term of school shall give written notice to the county superintendent of the time and place of beginning such school and the time when it will probably close. If such school is to be suspended for one week or more in such term, the teacher shall notify the county superintendent of such suspension. Chapter 15, Section 3802, Revised Code of 1943.

No teacher shall be entitled to or receive any compensation for the time he teaches in any public school without a certificate valid and in force for such time in the county where such school is taught, except that if a teacher's certificate shall expire by its own limitation within six weeks of the close of the term, such teacher may finish such term without re-examination or renewal of such certificate. Chapter 15, Section 3612, Revised Code of 1943.

Each teacher shall keep a school register and at the close of each term make a report containing the number of visits of the county superintendent and such items in such form as shall be required. Such report shall be made in duplicate, both copies of which shall be sent to the county superintendent, who, if he such report to be correct, shall immediately return one copy to the district clerk, same to be filed with him. No teacher shall be paid the last month's wages in any term until such report shall have been approved by the county superintendent and one copy returned to the district clerk. Chapter 15, Section 3803, Revised Code of 1943.

* * * A school week shall consist of five days and a school month of twenty days.

The legal school holidays are New Year's Day, Good Friday. Memorial Day, July 4th, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Each teacher in the common schools shall teach pupils, as they become sufficiently advanced to pursue the same, the following branches: Orthography, reading, spelling, writing, arithmetic, language lessons, English grammar, geography, United States history, civil government, physiology and hygiene, giving special instruction concerning the nature of alcoholic drinks and other narcotics and their effects upon the human system. All pupils in the above mentioned schools below the high school and above the third year of school work, computing from the beginning of the lowest primary year, shall receive instruction in this subject every year from the text books adapted to grade in the hands of the pupils for not less than four lessons per week for ten weeks of each school year. In all schools above mentioned, all pupils in the lower three primary school years shall each year be instructed orally in the subject for not less than three lessons per week for ten weeks of each school year by teachers using textbooks adapted to grade for each instruction as a guide or standard.

Each teacher shall keep a school register and shall make a final report which shall be made in duplicate, both of which must be sent to the county superintendent. If found to be correct, one copy is returned to the clerk of the school district.

A school week shall consist of five days and a school month of twenty days. 15-4704.

The United States flag shall be displayed in seasonable weather on each schoolhouse or upon a flagstaff on the school grounds of each school during the school hours of each day's session of school. 15-4711.

The legal school holidays are New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4th, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. 15-3804.

The third Friday in January is Temperance Day. At least one hour of the school day shall be set aside for instruction and appropriate exercises. 15-3805.

II. GENERAL

The school board may dismiss a teacher at any time for plain violation of contract, gross immorality, or flagrant neglect of duty. 15-2508.

Any teacher who ceases to be a teacher in this state without receiving any benefit from the fund, upon making written application to the board within eighteen months after he has discontinued teaching in North Dakota, shall be entitled to one half of the assessments which he has paid into the fund previous to July 1, 1947 and the full amount of the assessments paid into the fund after July 1, 1947. 15-3940.

| 4. This contract continues in effect unless the teacher is notified in writing not earlier than February 15 and not later than April 15 that h services are not required for the ensuing school term. However, the teacher shall be given at least thirty days or until May 1, whichever is the earlier, to reply to an offer of contract. Failure on the part of the teacher to accept said offer shall be deemed to be a rejection of the contract. (H.B. 583, S.L. 1959) |

In the event of breach of contract on the part of a teacher, the superintendent of public instruction shall suspend (attorney general has ruled that a hearing must be held previous to suspension) such teacher's certificate for a period of not to exceed one year, during which time it shall be unlawful for such teacher to receive payment for teaching in the public schools of North Dakota. Any teacher who comes from a school or educational institution supported by public taxation in another state of this nation and becomes a teacher in a public school or state institution within North Dakota may elect to have not to exceed seven years out of state teaching accredited in North Dakota provided he declares his request to the Board of Trustees of this fund for such out of state credit within the first year after he begins teaching in North Dakota.
